

## **Granite Removal Process**

- 1. Cut all caulk around granite
  - 2. Remove Sink
- 3. Heat up all seams and separate
  - 4. Remove Splash
- 5. Slide and lift separated pieces onto dolly
- 6. Store pieces in a secure location (applicable if attempting to save stone)

## **Tools Used in Removal Process**

16 oz. Hammer Flat Razor Blades

Flat and Phillips Head Screwdriver Razor Knife

Crescent wrench Butane Torch

Channel Locks Shims

4" Putty Knife Box Straight Edge

Six in one Painters tool C - Clamps
